

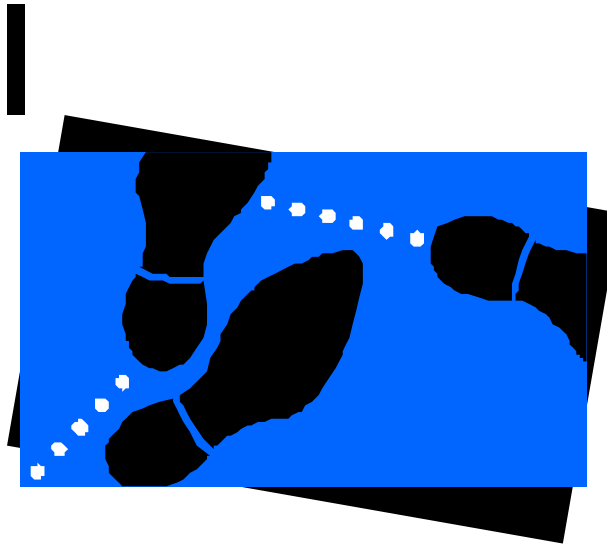

## How do I Borrow Materials?

Most library materials can be borrowed for free with a valid library card. If you live in California you may apply for a free card. Most libraries require photo identification and proof of your current address.

The library respects your privacy. We do not share any information about you outside the library system. Once you return library materials we keep no record of your borrowing history.

It's a good idea to become familiar with your library's loan policies and confirm the due date when you check out materials.
